

Accreditation Placement Rate Methodology

A graduate from the graduation cohort is considered eligible for placement unless they meet one of the five exemptions detailed below:

- a. The graduate is deceased
- b. The graduate is permanently disabled
- c. The graduate is deployed for military service/duty
- d. The graduate studied under a student visa and is ineligible for employment in the U.S.
- e. The graduate continued his/her education at an institution under the same ownership

The Salon Professional Academy includes students in the Placement Rate as employed by November 30 following the cohort in the Gainful Employment template.

State Placement Rate Methodology

A graduate from the graduation cohort is considered eligible for placement unless they have dropped, have been terminated by the school, or have ceased instruction in the program by any other manner (e.g., transferred to another curriculum at the school).

The Salon Professional Academy includes students in the Placement Rate as employed in their field within by the completion of the appropriate report and continuously employed in that field for 4 weeks.
